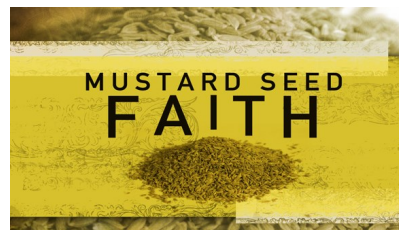

Diocesan Updates related to Mass during the pandemic
Please remember that we are STILL in the pandemic! As of Wednesday,
May 26th, only about 40% of Mississippians have been vaccinated

- ◆ We will continue with four Masses on the weekend, two in each
 Language. **Saturday evening Vigil Masses: 4:00 p.m. in English and**
6:00 p.m. in Spanish Sunday Masses: 11:00 a.m. in English and
1:30 p.m. in Spanish (both livestreamed by Facebook)
- ◆ **If you are fully vaccinated, you are not required to wear facemasks**
at church; those who are not fully vaccinated or not vaccinated at all
 are **recommended** to wear facemasks, including children and teens
- ◆ Social distancing will continue at least three feet apart – individuals or
 family units
- ◆ Holy Communion will continue to be distributed under one species,
 the host, and only in the hand.
- ◆ In-person meetings can take place, minding social distancing

 the 11 a.m. Mass on June 13th.

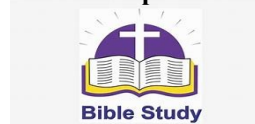
